Barbara Elliott Trust Fund for Innovative Ministries

The Barb Elliott Trust Fund for Innovative Ministries is a fund that is available for diaconal projects that are innovative and difficult to fund. This fund is still relatively new and needs ongoing donations to build its capital in order to provide a substantial amount of available interest.

In 2009 a grant of \$3,100.00 was awarded to Moscow United Church to help upgrade a small building for community use. Funds were used to purchase a composting toilet, a used flat top grill, commercial grade pots and pans and some miscellaneous kitchen utensils. Our contact was Elaine Kellogg.

In 2010 a grant of \$4,500.00 was made to the Sexual Assault Support Centre of Waterloo Region for a project Male Allies Against Sexual Violence (MAASV). Our contact was Joan Tuchlinsky.

In 2011 two grants were approved.

The first, \$1,000.00 for a spa day sponsored by Community Ministry, an outreach partnership of Calvary memorial United and St. Mark's Lutheran Church in downtown Kitchener. The intent is to initiate an ongoing foot care program. Our contact is Marilyn Shaw.

The second, \$5,000.00 will bring women and men together to participate in the community biography work related to stories of deaconesses and diaconal ministers being undertaken by Caryn Douglas. The project will draw on the concept of research as a lived process of empowerment. A tangible result will be a print resource and story material.
